3) The CAD incidence functions duly updated with latest information already placed at member area of www.EUROTRACS-project.eu.

CINECA is waiting for the new figures. IMIM is preparing the last changes. At the end of the week they will be ready.

The functions as they are now in the member area can be accessed and used even if the figures are not updated. The functions are properly working already.

4) Project coordinator visit to Prof Aldo Maggioni, ESC-EORP Scientific Coordinator, setup for next January 12th.

A visit to Prof Aldo Maggioni has been set up for January the 12th. This meeting is important to make sure that we are using correctly the Euroheart survey data provided by the ESC. These data were provided by Prof. Shlomo Behar (who passed away some years ago) for the EUPHORIC project and also for the EURHOBOP project.

5) Data collection on costs forms already received on the web site.

They have been changed from the initial shape to allow some more digits to be entered. All countries except Portugal have entered their data.

The data from Portugal were sent in an excel file to Irene Roman.

IMIM will prepare the database and will send it to OBLIKUE.

6) Forthcoming deliverables:

a. WP5 (D6 cost-effectiveness analysis of population interventions). Due in January 2015

We have one month and a half to prepare D6. Max Brosa might send some queries during December. At mid-January he will have a draft of D6.

Marina Torre sent the partners last week the last version of the Dissemination Plan that included the list of publications decided during the meeting in Athens, and some updating about the activities of every partner dissemination. The list of the activities proposed by IMIM was also sent to be used as a reference list for the rest of partners. **Partners are requested then to describe in 10 lines their list of activities by the end of December.**

This will be another submission of the Dissemination Plan, but there can be as many submissions as changes in the document.





7) Possible presentation of preliminary results of EUROTRACS at CD-HA Workshop (The Hague, February 13th 2015) in session 3: Cost-effectiveness of Health interventions. "Economic aspects of chronic diseases prevention & management". Invitation by the Spanish National Contact Point.

In line with the Dissemination Plan, Jaume Marrugat has been invited by the Spanish National Contact Point from SANCO-CHAFEA to present the EUROTRACS project during the *Chronic Disease and Healthy Aging Workshop* to be held in The Hague next February 13th 2015. J Marrugat asks for the partners opinion on this matter before definitively accept this invitation.

In February WP5 will not be completed, so we will not be able to present final results.

Max Brosa suggests preparing some preliminary results, even if not all of them.

Marina Torre comments that there is no need to present results, but the important is to remark that we will have them in a very practical context.

J Marrugat will then represent the group in the workshop.

b. IJC EURHOBOP paper review submitted.

c. New link in the EURHOBOP web site ready for pre-registration of people interested in the EURHOBOP benchmarking functions

The meeting has been very successful. There were mainly journalists and we reached quite a lot of journals in Spain. J Marrugat presented how the system works, and taking into account that the IJC is going to accept now our EURHOBOP paper, we have set up in the EURHOBOP website a new option that he showed during the presentation how this works.

This is very good news because EURHOBOP is more and more popular. We are going to use it in a Spain in a new study called ATHOS.
